ABOUT GRAND VIEW UNIVERSITY

Grand View University is a liberal arts institution located in Des Moines, Iowa. As the state capital with a population exceeding half a million, Des Moines offers GV students diverse cultural and entertainment attractions, as well as outstanding opportunities for internships, jobs, and other educational experiences.

The university was founded in 1896 by Danish immigrants and is affiliated with the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. More than 2,000 students choose from 40 majors, including music and music education programs. For nearly two decades, close to 100 percent of GV graduates have secured employment or entered graduate school within six months of graduation. Typically, more than 98% of our full-time day undergraduate students receive financial assistance, totaling more than \$36.5 million. Grand View offers 25 sports for men and women, as well as athletic scholarships. With more than 40 clubs and campus organizations and three honors programs, students have many opportunities to get involved and learn



to lead for life. Grand View's College for Professional and Adult Learning serves students in central Iowa offering 16 majors, most in an accelerated format, to allow students to work full-time while they complete a degree.

Grand View offers four graduate programs: Master of Education, Master of Science in Nursing, Master of Science in Organizational Leadership, and Master of Science in Sport Management.

Recent Grand View Highlights

The Music Department moved into its newly-renovated facility this past summer. The new location provides increased space for rehearsals, classroom teaching, studio teaching, and practice rooms. In other campus

improvements, the Student Center opened for students Fall 2016 and houses performance spaces, campus dining facilities, classrooms, and office space for various departments. Grand View recently launched a new program offering a Bachelor of Social Work. GV also continues to engage in international partnerships, including opportunities for exchange in Denmark and China.

ABOUT THE CONDUCTOR

Tony Garmoe is currently band director at Clive Learning Academy and Westridge Elementary School in the West Des Moines Community School District. He has taught at Pekin High School (1982-1984), Saydel High School (1984-1987), Woodside Middle School (1987-1988), The University of Iowa (Graduate Assistant, 1988-1990), Plainfield (Illinois) High School (1990-1991), and Valley High School (1991-2013). He received his bachelor's degree in music education from Truman State University (formerly Northeast Missouri State University) in 1982 and his master of music in conducting from the University of Iowa in 1990. He has completed additional work at The University of Minnesota, the University of Seattle, Iowa State University, and Drake University. His professional affiliations include, or have included, the Iowa Bandmasters Association, Music Educators National Conference, Iowa Music Educators, World Association of Symphonic Bands and Ensembles, International Association of Jazz Educators and Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia.

Tony has been awarded a Northwestern University Summer Music Fellowship, the Stanbury Outstanding Young Band Director Award, and a Council for Basic Education Fellowship to study the small ensemble music of Armstrong, Parker, Davis and Coltrane. He was awarded a Fulbright-Hayes Scholarship and studied in Poland and Hungary for six weeks in 1995. In 1997, he was a member of the Fulbright Teacher Delegation, in Komatsu City, Japan. His professional interests rest in the areas of literature, conducting, and chamber music. As a member of IBA he has served as the Convention Equipment Chairperson, Publicity Chairperson, Concert Band Affairs Committee Chairperson (providing leadership and direction for the IHSMA Concert Band Literature List), SCIBA President, and President of the Iowa Bandmasters Association.

Ensembles under his direction have performed at the Iowa Bandmasters Association Conference, Illinois Music Educators Association Conference, Midwest International Band and Orchestra Conference, Iowa State Honor Band and Conductors Symposium and at Hancher Auditorium at The University of Iowa in shared concert with The University of Iowa Symphony Band. Ensembles within the Valley High School Band Program have received regional, national, and international recognition. In 1999, the Valley High School Music Department received the first ever Grammy Signature School Award for exemplary high school music programs. In 2001, the VHS Symphony Band was the 4A Honor Band for the Iowa Bandmasters Conference and in 2005 and 2012 served as a rehearsal clinic ensemble for the International Band and Orchestra Clinic, in Chicago, Illinois. In 2008 small chamber ensembles from the VHS Symphony Band performed at the Gallagher Bluedorn Auditorium on the campus of the University of Northern Iowa in addition to the 2013 Iowa Bandmasters Association Conference. Tony provided philosophical and organizational leadership for ValleyFest, one of the largest single-day marching band festivals in the Midwest, and he remains active as a clinician, consultant, adjudicator, conductor, and performing musician.
